Step 2

Completed Pallets or Gaylords First Wrap

- Items are placed on pallets (max height: 65 inches).
- Once a pallet is full, workers hand-wrap it with clear plastic.
- Pallets move to a staging area, awaiting further processing.

Step 3

Blue Wrap

- Forklifts transport pallets to an automatic wrapping machine.
- Pallets are wrapped with thick blue plastic for secure storage.

How Sortables are Received

- Sortable items (smaller inventory) arrive in yellow totes.
- Processed in Gaylords with color-coded categorization.
- Scanners direct items to the appropriate Gaylord.


Storing Pallets

- Forklifts move wrapped pallets to storage racks:
 - Bulkier pallets are stored separately if they exceed size limits.
- Pallets remain in storage until the order is confirmed and shipment is planned.

Step 1

Unloading and Sorting

- Trucks arrive
- Employees unload inventory onto conveyor belts.
- Items are scanned and grouped by category.









Step 5

Staging and Outbound Shipments

- Once an order is confirmed for pickup (usually within 24 hours):
 - Pallets are removed from storage and staged in designated areas.
- Truck loading by dock door
- Pallets await truck arrival for outbound shipment (usually within 5 business days!)
